DID YOU KNOW

- Good Friday commemorates the crucifixion of Jesus Christ and his death at Calvary, and Easter Sunday commemorates his resurrection.
- Good Friday is observed each year on the Friday preceding Easter Sunday, which this year also coincides with the Jewish observance of Passover.
- The crucifixion, death, and resurrection of Jesus are central to Christian faith.
- Easter is a joyous holiday for Christians, since it marks the fulfillment of the Biblical prophecy of the coming of the Messiah.
- In addition to the religious significance, Easter is celebrated as a spring holiday with themes of rebirth, gathering together with family and friends, and sharing special foods.
