




DC – Quality Control / DOT Tires

Purpose The U.S. Department of Transportation requires that all tires DOT information be documented and transmitted at the time of purchase.

- Guidelines**
- DOT's are documented in the same way for Individual tires and for mounted tires.
 - When a DOT is found by SRS to be older than 4 years old:
 - Set aside and inform your senior so he/she can remove the tire from stock the proper way.
 - If possible have a replacement tire pulled.
 - We are not required to DOT DT/AT store orders however, the **"Quality Control"** check is still required.
 - A **Quality Control** Check must always be performed by a Full Time Employee to **MAKE SURE IT IS RIGHT**.

QUALITY CONTROL/ DOTing Tires

Follow these steps to accurately DOT all tires:

Step	Action
1	Using SRS and under the "Capture DOT" screen, scan the packages tracking number on the shipping label.
2	<p>Once the "Quality Control" popup appears, verify that all product is included is correct and in good condition.
