
Follow the steps below to prepare new - aged listings on eBay & set the best offer boundaries.










Follow the steps below carefully. You will need the following systems:




Process:

STEP	ACTION
1	<p>Open the Aged Database and click Export Template</p> 
How to edit the template:	
1A	In Column A (SKU) - Check for duplicates and <i>delete</i> any that appear
1B	In Column D (Brand) - Fill in any blanks. You can find the information on the DTD website by using the article # from <i>column B</i> . If the brand is <i>missing</i> from Column D, you will need to <i>add the brand to the title in Column H</i>
1C	<i>Delete Column I (Cond)</i>

1D	<p>In Column K (UPC) - <i>Highlight the whole column and select the yellow exclamation icon, to convert all to a number</i></p> 
1E	<p>While Column K is still highlighted, go up to the display ribbon (number section) and choose 'number' in the dropdown</p> 
1F	<p>Then click the 'decimal to reduce' button until they are gone</p> 
1G	<p>In Column M (Image) - Make sure all listings have a <i>picture</i>. If they do <u>not</u> - you can find them on the website, using the article number from column B</p>
1H	<p>In Column R (Retail Price) - If the price is over \$1,000 you will need to <i>get rid of the comma</i></p>
1I	<p>In Column Y (Aspect Ratio) - <i>Convert to a number again</i> (Refer to step 1D)</p>
1J	<p>In Column AT (Rim Diameter) & AU (Section Width) - <i>Convert to a number also</i></p>
1K	<p>Save the template. Select File > Save As > Browse > Mdrive > EBAY > Accessories > Aged Projects & create a new folder there. Title the new folder with today's date followed by 'aged'</p> 
1L	<p>Name the file 'Full_tire_template' and select CSV(Macintosh) for the 'Save as type' > Click Save</p> 

2	<p>Send a message in the 'Running Updates' V2 chat, asking if you can load new. Once they say 'you are good', open eBay V2 & click Go to listing builder</p> 
3	<p>From the drop down, select Tire. Then click Import full template (this will open your files). <i>Navigate to your saved template in the Mdrive. Once selected, the program should automatically run & load the listings</i></p> 
4	<p>Click the white arrow on the top left corner to navigate back to the main screen</p> 
5	<p>Click Go to Store Maintenance</p> 
6	<p>Click Add new listings. Wait until it says <i>complete</i></p> 
7	<p>Now that you have loaded the new product, you need to <i>add best offers</i> to these listings. This is done in eBay on the Manage Active Listings page</p>
8	<p>Under Categories select the dropdown for Tires. Then select Aged Inventory. Click Search</p> 

9	<p>Select Best Offer – eligible from under the quick filters section</p> 
10	<p>Check the box next to <i>all the listings that the 'Current Price' is more than \$45</i>. Once all are selected click Actions > Add best offer</p> 
11	<p>Check the box next to 'Automatically accept offers of at least'. Click the <i>drop down</i> to select 'Percentage off' and <i>add</i> the amount of 20 in the box</p> <p>✓ Add Best Offer to your listing</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Automatically accept offers of at least</p> 
12	<p>Check box 'Automatically decline offers lower than'. Click the <i>drop down</i> to say 'Percentage off' and <i>add</i> the amount of 35 in the box</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Automatically decline offers lower than</p> 
13	<p>In the bottom right corner, click Add Best Offer</p> 
14	<p>Go back to the <i>Aged Database</i> and click Update Item ID's</p> 
15	<p>Then go up to the <i>ribbons</i> and click Refresh All</p> 
16	<p>The number next to '<i>Export Template</i>' should now say 0, indicating all listings were added</p>  <p>You are all done!</p>
