



DC - Labeling for Racks, Articles, and Pallets

Introduction To create and print labels for racks, articles, or pallets, be sure to use a computer with the appropriate Zebra printer set up to print the kind of labels you want to print.

Procedure Follow these steps to create and print labels for your racks, articles, or pallets:

| 1 | Open SRS Inventory Manager. | |
| 2 | Select More > Labels from the Main Menu. The Labels screen opens:  |  |

| | Rack Labels | Key in Location From and Location To fields. <ul style="list-style-type: none">For one label, enter the same info in both fields.Warning: Be careful: If you enter a range, you will print labels for the entire range. |
| | Article Labels | Key in Article field and number of copies you want. |
| | Pallet Labels | Key in Pallet ID field. Note: To automatically increment to the next ID, select Create New Pallet ID button. |
| 4 | Verify that your printer is turned on, loaded with labels, and ready, then select the appropriate Print button (e.g. Print Article , Print Locations , or Print Pallet ID) to print out the label(s). | |
