Is the strategy connected to your customers, capabilities, context, and the bottom line?

- Who are your team's most important external and internal customers?
- What do they want or need from you?

TEAM CAPABILITIES

- What does your team do best?
- Where are the gaps?

STRATEGIC CONTEXT

- What factors does your team need to understand and consider?

BOTTOM LINE

- How does your team add value?
- How do you impact the bottom line?
