







Installing Microsoft Intune to an iOS Device

Introduction Microsoft Intune is a mobile device management platform that enables you to work productively and securely from anywhere, at any time from a registered mobile device. This QRG will walk you through how to download the Microsoft Intune Company Portal app to your iOS mobile phone or device. Consider the following:

- The Microsoft Authenticator app must be downloaded and enrolled/setup to use Microsoft Intune and other company software. For instructions, refer to the [Setup Microsoft Authenticator QRG](#).
- You will be prompted to setup a 6-character passcode on your device if that is not set.











Procedure Follow these steps to install the Intune Company Portal app to your iOS mobile device.

Download the app

Step	Action	
1	On your mobile device, download the Intune Company Portal app from the App Store.	
2	Open the Intune Company Portal app on your mobile device and sign in with your Discount Tire User ID (email address) and password. You will be prompted for Multi-Factor Authentication	 
3	When the initial set up screen appears, select Begin . Review the Discount Tire privacy settings and select Continue .	 
4	Review the installation steps and click Continue . You will be asked to go to your mobile device settings to setup your profile.	







Setup profile on device

Step	Action	
5	Go to your mobile device's Settings > General > Profile > Management Profile > Install > Install.	  
6	Click Trust when prompted. Click Done . The Management Profile is now setup.	 
7	Return to the MS Intune app and select "Yes, I installed the profile."	
8	Select the category for your device (Company owned or User owned) and click Continue . Click Continue on the next screen.	 
9	You will be asked to install some standard apps (OneDrive, Outlook, Teams, SharePoint, Edge browser, and Office). Click Install for each one. They will install in the background. <i>Note: If you already have these apps on your phone, you will be asked to allow Discount Tire to take management of the existing app(s). Click Manage.</i> <i>Note: This will not affect any personal data. This will only allow Discount Tire to protect Discount Tire data.</i>

Step	Action	
10	<p>If you do not have a passcode for your device or have a passcode that does not meet the criteria of Discount Tire, you will be prompted to setup a passcode (6-digit pin)., you will be prompted to setup a passcode (6-digit pin). Select Change Now and enter your pin.</p> <p><i>If the passcode is already set without the criteria set, there will be a prompt to re-enter the old passcode followed by the new passcode.</i></p> <p><i>This will not impact facial or biometric access you have set for the device.</i></p>	
11	<p>Enter your password for Outlook. Select Edit Settings and enter it there.</p>	
12	<p>Return to the MS Intune App. Click Done on the All Set screen.</p>	
13	<p>In the MS Intune App Notifications pop-up, select your notification preferences.</p>	
14	<p>If you have contacts in Outlook setup on your computer, Intune will sync them with your phone for easy access.</p> <p>Select OK to allow your Outlook contacts to sync to the Contacts app on your phone.</p> <p>Select OK to import your contacts.</p> <p><i>Note: This will not impact or affect your existing contacts on your phone.</i></p>	
15	<p>You may be prompted to turn on Notifications for Outlook. If you want notifications, click Turn On.</p>
