



Oregon Paid Sick Leave* (Part-Time Employees)

Eligibility All part-time employees in Oregon who have completed 90 days of employment are eligible for Paid Sick Leave (PSL).

PSL Accrual: Part-time employees accrue PSL from their date of hire at the rate of 1 hour of PSL per 30 hours worked.

PSL Usage: Time off may be taken in one-hour increments up to a total of 40 hours PSL for part-time employees.

Using Sick Time A part-time employee can use PSL for the following reasons:

- Diagnosis, care, or treatment of an existing health condition of, or preventive care for, an employee or an employee's family member.
- If an employee is the victim of domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking.
- Baby bonding to care for an infant or newly adopted child.

Amount of Sick Time A part-time employee may use up to 40 hours of PSL a year.

PSL Carryover Part-time employees may carry over up to 72 hours of PSL from one calendar year to the next.
