AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY

- ➔ Verify the Workflow Manager has installed bead breaker grips on all changers
- ➔ If any are missing, instruct the WAM to Order grips from your warehouse
- ➔ Set a clear expectation and follow up to ensure the grips were installed

THREAD SHAKER WITH GUARD

An improved Thread Shaker is now available that the socket doesn't get stuck on. Order on the **KC (EZ Garage)**. After the new thread shaker arrives, the old one should be removed and discarded.

EQUIPMENT ORDER: Thread Shaker ➔



STORES WILL BE:



- ✓ Testing all torque wrenches **daily**
- ✓ Ensuring all electronics work properly
- ✓ Verifying torque validator is secure to wall
- ✓ Checking torque wrench for accuracy, removing it from service if inaccurate and placing it in the red holder

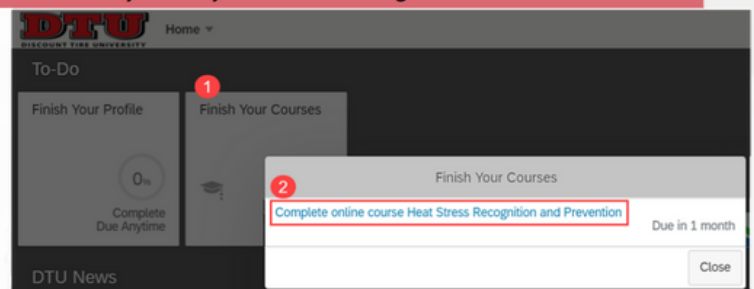


ACCESS TO THE TRAINING MODULES
