CRITICAL TO SAFETY

A valid driver's license is necessary to move vehicles.

- Always be aware of your surroundings as you approach the vehicle
- Adjust the seat and mirrors so you can see behind and beside the vehicle
- Remember to check your blind spot – Be aware of objects around you
- Make sure your path is clear to drive
- Backup slowly!
- Be aware of the front of the car while backing out
- Remember, there is not a guide! Take extra care to be aware of your surroundings.
- Do not play with the radio or use your phone while operating the vehicle.

Last month, we asked you to demonstrate safe lifting techniques in the morning huddle. Below are a few responses from your peers:

Hand placement is a very important topic that was covered this month, wheels and lug nuts. Our service techs are very mindful of this and always are working safe.

The biggest struggle I found was the techs holding and opening their hand on the socket when bolting up. Getting them to not do it took specific in the moment coaching.

It starts with the initial training, so we are reinforcing the good habit and aren't having to break old habits. Everyone was receptive to understanding the why we do it this way.

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As a team we are very good at making sure we get proper thread engagement and keeping our hands clear of the clamps on the tire changers.

My people were very receptive to the updated BP. one thing we really need to have gotten better at since is when using a hammer to either break locks or remove a swollen lug is use the shaker and the goggles, knowing now they are there to keep us from injuring our hands and eyes

One thing that still needs attention is clamping from the outside in. Everyone does a great job when we are slow until we get busy. We will continue to put focus on this but also cover the whys behind what we are asking.

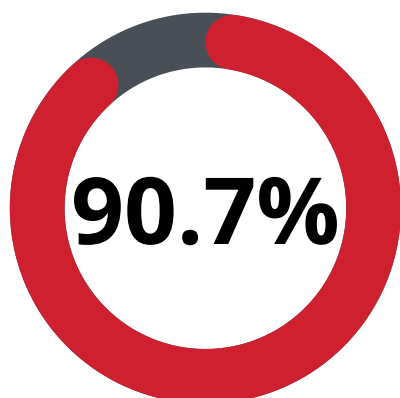

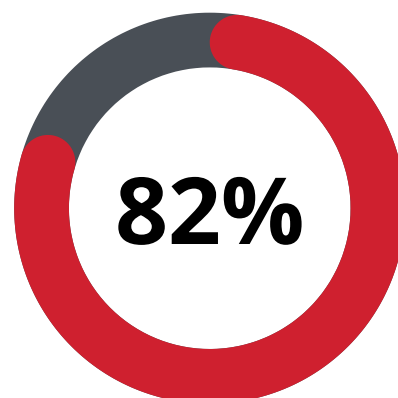
