

## Cordless Impacts QRG for Store Managers

### Introduction

The ½” Milwaukee Cordless Impact Driver has been updated with new programming specifically for Discount Tire/America’s Tire which requires a minor change in the install process. Review the information below to ensure that your employees understand the updated process expectations and that any existing impact drivers are handled appropriately.

### Before Putting into Service

Once the new ½” Milwaukee Cordless Impact Drivers are delivered to your store, and before putting them into service, ensure:

Step	Action
1	All employees have reviewed the Using Cordless Impacts Operational Best Practice, understand the process change, and have completed the Acknowledgement in the LMS.
2	If cordless impacts are replacing pneumatic impact drivers remove from service and handle appropriately. (See <i>What to do With Existing Tools</i> section below.)
3	Once the above steps have been completed, log into the LMS and complete the Milwaukee Cordless Impact Drivers Update for Store Managers Acknowledgement.

### What to do With Existing Tools

**½” Pneumatic Impact Drivers:** Keep as many as is needed for your store to service dually and heavy trucks. The rest should be removed from service.

**Non-Milwaukee Cordless Impact Drivers:** These should be discarded immediately, as they are not approved for use.

**½” Milwaukee Cordless Impact Driver:** All Milwaukee Impact Drivers purchased by stores through non-Discount Tire approved vendors need to be sent to the warehouse to be evaluated by the warehouse manager.
