





Raising Rivian Electric Delivery Van (EDV) Vehicles QRG

**Purpose** To be able to properly and safely lift Rivian EDV vehicles.



**Using the Rivian Jack Adapter**

Follow these steps when lifting Rivian EDV vehicles:

Step	Action	
1	Collect the lift adapters and stage them next to the vehicle.  <b>Note:</b> Only lift vehicles on a flat surface and only use jacks with saddle pads.	
2	Locate the proper lift points on the undercarriage of the vehicle.  <b>Note:</b> The lifting points are noted with a ▼ on the side skirt of the van.	 
3	Place the adapter in the appropriate lift point.  <b>Note:</b> Lift points are part of the frame, and have a semi-circle cutout for the adapter contact surface to fit in.

**Lifting the Vehicle**

4	Center jack pad under the adapter and begin to raise vehicle.	
5	Repeat Steps 3 and 4 for the remaining lift points.

 CRITICAL TO SAFETY	When servicing four new tires, lift one side of the vehicle at a time (two people recommended) to ensure even weight distribution.	
	Never enter the zone beneath a lifted vehicle.	
6	Once the service has been completed, lower the vehicle, remove the adapters, and return them to their proper storage location.
