Requirements for Bayside Conversion

You will need to meet the following requirements before requesting to convert to the Bayside environment.

AVP
AVP is a certified Workflow Coach
Regions
Hosted a Workflow Event with RMOQ
Holding Workflow Events in stores
Hosting improvement calls on a consistent cadence using the Discount Tire coaching questions to understand what managers are seeing in their stores
Support resources are being sent to RMOQ: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bayside Improvement Logs• Flow of Task Observation
Stores
Consistently scheduling uninterrupted 4-person play in Bayside
Achieve an SQDC score of at least 7.5
Achieving at least 90+ Invoice average demand when supporting Bayside BP of uninterrupted 4-person play
Show understanding of Phase 3 – Standardized Workflow with an 18-minute or less bay time average over a 90-day period

How to Request Conversion to Bayside

If a store meets the requirements and wants to convert to the Bayside environment, the Regional Office will fill out the [Bayside Conversion Request Form](#), which can be found on the [Service Area Workflow Improvement KC page](#).

After submitting the form, stores will be evaluated, notified about their transition decision, and provided next steps.

FAQs

Q Why don't we convert all stores to the Bayside environment?

A Bayside can be a magnifying glass into store Workflow processes, and not all stores would benefit from the conversion at this time. If a store executes Workflow at a low level, Bayside will make the store's throughput lower.

Q How long will it take for Bayside equipment to arrive after being approved to convert to Bayside?

A The Tools/Equipment and Facilities teams will take care of ordering equipment. It will take up to 30 days for in stock equipment to arrive after approval to transition to Bayside.

Q Will we open new stores with a Bayside environment?

A All new stores will open with a non-Bayside setup.

- Why? Bayside can be more complicated to execute at a lower customer demand.
- The store can be converted to Bayside at a later time when the requirements are met. During construction, the inground conduit will be installed but will be capped for future use.

Q Does the Bayside environment allow for the same number of bays in a workcell?

A No, the Bayside environment will take the current workcell down from 2 bays to 1 bay.
